This Addendum is issued to provide responses to vendor questions received regarding MACC 911's Request for Proposals for Aerial Imagery Subscription Services.

This Addendum shall become part of the RFP documents. Except as specifically clarified or modified by this Addendum, all other terms, conditions, requirements, deadlines, and provisions of the RFP remain unchanged.

Vendor Questions and MACC 911 Responses

Question 1:

Can MACC 911 provide shapefiles for the area of interest?

Response:

MACC 911 is not providing shapefiles at this time. Vendors should base their proposals on the Area of Interest as described in the RFP.

The primary Area of Interest is **Grant County, Washington**, with additional required coverage areas including the **Town of Coulee Dam** and **Wanapum Indian Village**. Optional coverage areas may include **Adams County** and/or **statewide Washington coverage**, as described in the RFP.

Vendors are responsible for reviewing the RFP and preparing proposals based on the stated Area of Interest and optional coverage areas.

Question 2:

Who is MACC 911's CAD software provider and what version are they running?

Response:

MACC 911 is currently using **365Labs** as its CAD provider and is in the process of transitioning back to **Motorola Solutions Spillman Flex CAD**. MACC 911 may also evaluate or transition to other CAD or public safety software platforms during the term of any resulting agreement.

Because MACC 911's CAD environment may change over time, proposed imagery services should support modern public safety GIS and CAD workflows, including:

- ESRI-based GIS environments;
- Web-based mapping;
- Tiled imagery services;
- Common geospatial service formats; and
- The ability to support integration with current or future CAD platforms.

Vendors should not design their proposal solely around one CAD platform. MACC 911 is seeking an imagery solution that supports flexible GIS-based interoperability.

Question 3:

Can MACC 911 provide a sample contract or list of Terms and Conditions for review?

Response:

MACC 911 anticipates using a professional services/subscription agreement that will be reviewed by MACC 911 and legal counsel prior to execution.

At a minimum, MACC 911 anticipates requiring terms addressing the following:

- Scope of services;
- Subscription access;
- Licensing and permitted use;
- Multi-agency access and use;
- Data security;
- Insurance;
- Indemnification;
- Public records compliance;

- Termination;
- Governing law;
- Payment terms; and
- Any service-level or performance commitments proposed by the vendor.

Vendors may include their standard subscription agreement, licensing terms, or proposed terms and conditions with their proposal for MACC 911's review.

MACC 911 reserves the right to negotiate final contract terms with the selected vendor prior to execution of any agreement.
